



MHS Softball Booster Club Scholarship Program

The MHS Softball Booster Club will award (\$1,500.00) in scholarships for 2009.

PURPOSE:

To support and encourage MHS softball athletes who choose to pursue higher education and to recognize the student-athlete who demonstrates character traits such as leadership, sportsmanship, accountability, integrity, a strong work ethic, responsibility and perseverance.

Application Instructions:

1. Complete the MHSBC application and submit all required documentation. You can pick up the MHS Softball Booster Club Scholarship application in the MHS athletic office and complete application by due date.
2. All requirements must be met and all information completed for an application to be considered.
3. The application form should be given in a sealed envelope to the coach/nominator/committee chairman who will be responsible to forward the information the MHS Softball Booster Club selection committee.

MHS Softball Booster Club Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must have a high school GPA of 3.0 or better.
2. Applicant must have qualified for a letter as a senior and demonstrated leadership.
3. No UIL contract violations during junior and senior year.
4. Must supply proof of application or letter of acceptance to an accredited college, university, or institute.

5. Applicants may be asked to interview in front of the MHS Softball Scholarship Selection Committee upon request.

Scholarship Appropriations:

1. Student must provide proof of full-time student status. (as defined by their college, university, or institute.)
2. After receiving proof of admission and full-time student status, the scholarship money will be sent directly to the recipient's college, university, or institute.

MHS Softball Booster Club Scholarship Recommendations:

1. The full amount of the check will be sent directly to the school on behalf of the student.
2. Award (\$1,500.00) in scholarship(s) based on the eligibility requirements.
3. A MHSBC selection committee will be selected by majority vote at the MHS Softball Booster Club meeting in February. In March the committee will select the scholarship recipient(s) (date may be subject to change). The Committee will be comprised of a minimum of three members.
 - a. Two of which will be current Booster Club members in good standing with the club. These members cannot have a player eligible for this award.
 - b. The third member will be a community member with no connection to players.
 - c. The Booster Club President will appoint one member as chair of this committee. The committee will be reappointed each year.
 - d. Parents or guardians of scholarship applicants are not allowed to participate on the scholarship selection committee.
4. The MHS Softball Booster Club/ Funding Committee are responsible to raise the needed scholarship budget each year.
5. Distribution of the scholarships will be distributed through the MHS Softball Booster Club and awarded at the banquet in the spring.
